

# OPERATION TRANSITION WARRIOR

The American Legion Riders (ALR) of Arizona are trying to assist our Veterans returning home from Iraq and Afghanistan to Arizona who are not able to work due to combat injuries. Between the time our government releases them from active duty and the time their disability can take affect could be years. During this time they have little or no money to support their family. The second purpose of OTW is to assist families of our military who are deployed in Iraq and Afghanistan, and need emergency monetary assistance.

We are trying to raise money to assist our Veterans during their transition period. We are calling this program “Operation Transition Warrior”. We **will not** give them money but we **will pay** for their rent, utilities, purchase food and other functions to meet their needs. Our goal, within the ALR, is to raise a minimum of \$50,000 this year. We cannot raise this amount without your help and the help of others, any donation(s) would be greatly accepted. **100%** of all donation/funds will go towards this cause and all operating expenses will be from our Legion Rider Chapter general fund account.
